WHAT ARE THEY NEEDED FOR?

Middle school in 1 year



- Access to **high schools and professional schools** (Enaip electrician, mechanic, etc; hair dresser/beautician school; health services operator course OSS; tailor school...);
- UE residency permit for long-term residents;
- Italian citizenship;
- More chances to find a job;
- Anything for which an A2 level is required.

A2 exam Integration



- **UE residency permit for long-term residents:** an exam that the Commissariato del Governo or Cinformi ask you to take when you apply for this kind of residency permit and you do not already hold an A2 certificate or a middle school diploma. It is free. There are exam sessions once a month.

A2 level certificates



- UE residency permit for long-term residents;
- **Driving license** preparation courses offered by Centro EdA and others;
- Voucher-courses, refundable courses, internships, demand and supply matching database of the **Job Agency.**

You get this certificate after finishing the A2-level Italian language course at Centro EdA and passing the test (these courses cost around 27 euros for the whole school year, from October to May). The certificate is recognized everywhere in Italy.

B1 exam Citizenship



- Italian citizenship

People holding an UE residency permit for long-term residents do not need to take this exam. The exam costs 100 euros. Exam sessions are scheduled 2-3 times a year. If you do not pass the exam you can take it again for how many times you like, paying the fee each time.

C.I.L.S. exams (all levels Italian language certificates)



For A2 and B1 levels go to "A2 exam Integration" and "B1 exam Citizenship". Unlike the others, this certificate is recognized even outside Italy. You can take it for a fee, in exam sessions that are scheduled 3-4 times a year. If you do not pass specific sections of the exam you can try again those sections for a reduced fee.
